Standing Nudes is a watercolor that perfectly illustrates this fusion of rigor and spontaneity. The composition features two female figures, depicted with a rich and varied color palette. The dynamic brushstrokes and bold pencil lines give the bodies a vitality and almost tangible presence. The vivid colors and contrasting shadows create a subtle interplay of light that adds depth and volume to the forms.
