very rare piece of defense for guards / police officers etc. in the samurai period To compare with the traditional jite style, but here in the shape of a miniature sword very solid steel construction to ward off saber blows during the feudal system of Japan, it was forbidden to carry a sword to the shogun's palace; this was also the rule for the palace guards, who had a police role. extremely rare in this form construction in steel, copper, shakudo and wood
