Description

Gabriel-Joseph-Marie-Augustin Ferrier (1847 in Nîmes - 1914 in Paris) is a French portraitist and orientalist.

He exhibited for the first time at the Salon of 1869.

Two years later, he received the Prix de Rome for his representation of a scene from the Flood and studied at the Académie de France in Rome from 1873 to 1876. Back in France, he specializes in producing portraits of personalities linked to the Third Republic.

In 1883, he made a long trip to Algeria, where he created works in the orientalist style[1], some of which earned him a gold medal at the Universal Exhibition of 1889.
