19th C. WALNUT WOOD SEAT IN THE RENAISSANCE STYLE says: "DANTESCA or DAGOBERT"

THE BASE OF THE SCABELLE IS MADE OF TWO PARALLEL CARVED UPRIGHTS REINNISHED BY THE CREAMS AND OVAL BASE OF THE SEAT IN ITS MEDIUM PART WITH REINFORCEMENT OF SIDE CREAMS AND BASSES USING BASICS.

THE FRONT PANEL, CUT IN THE FASHION OF A CARTRIDGE, PRESENTS A LARGE SCULPTURE OF A LEONID HEAD.
THE BACK PRESENTS A CARVED PANEL IN ITS CENTER OF A LEONID HEAD ON A BACKGROUND OF RINCEAUX IN A LARGE-FRAME MOLDED FRAME, TOP WITH A CAPITAL AND A LOW
