Original writing desk in natural cherry and walnut wood, it opens on a projecting facade, with 4 leaves through a central flap revealing ten layettes and niches, the lower part with doors and the 2 pendant sides opening with 2 doors and two drawers Arched legs at the front and those at the back arranged in the extension of the rounded uprights Most certainly a dresser piece of furniture, original workmanship, this interesting secretary is presented in "good" condition, in a pretty blond patina It is of a work from the Transition period from the mid-18th century
