Description

- Champagne bucket in silver metal from the Ercuis goldsmith house with Louis XVI style decoration of pearl moldings on the edge of the neck of the champagne bucket. - Side grips with movable ring to attach to Pho dog masks. - Pearl model. - Goldsmith's mark with the centaur with the letters O and E and the mention Ercuis and the number 69 in a rounded hollow engraved under the underside of the champagne bucket. - The centaur hallmark was deposited at the precious metals guarantee office in Paris in 1866, then the letters O and E were added for Orfèvrerie Ercuis. - Square hallmark with the number 30, the number corresponds to the mass of silver used to silver the piece, in this case 30g of silver for this champagne bucket. - Note a few small scratches from use on the champagne bucket but
