Grandson of the famous British novelist Edward Bulwer-Lytton (1803-1873), Neville Bulwer-Lytton was born in Calcutta in 1879 while his father Robert, a diplomat, held the position of Viceroy of India. He first studied at Eton College (UK) before joining the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris. An associate of the National Society of Fine Arts, he exhibited his first works in the early 1900s. These included watercolor landscapes and oil on canvas portraits representing eminent personalities of his time. He also exhibits his paintings in several galleries and museums in England, including the Royal Academy of Arts, the Royal Society of portrait
