Description

Court sword with chiseled bronze mount, Louis XVI period, 18th century. Chiseled bronze frame, olive pommel with riveting button. Joining arch with 1 branch with posterior quillon, no donkey and decorative escutcheon. 4-sided fuse and 1767 model pontat tray, the entire frame is decorated with diamond pearls. Pontat decorated on both sides with diamond pearls and cord at the edge with ribbon knots. Blade with median flat with 2 edges, engraved in one third with different floral motifs and bearing marking in a cartridge at the heel of the blade on both sides: LEFEUVRE, harquebusier and furnisher in Carcassonne. Without sheath. Length: 99 cm Length of the blade: 82.5 cm Width of the blade at the heel: 2.7 cm Good condition of conservation and use, in its original state, see the details in the photos.
