Albert Marquet met Marcelle Martinet in January 1920 in Algiers. She is a blackfoot woman with character. She serves as his interpreter. He is forty-five years old and does not want to commit to a permanent marriage, and yet they will never leave each other. The marriage was celebrated on February 10, 1923 in Algiers, the city of their first meeting. She takes care to give him his absolute freedom, managing the career of her illustrious painter, handling administrative matters, even taking care of his
