Important pair of cast iron torch holders with a dark patina.

Louis GASNE (model of), blacksmith master in Tusey (Meuse).

A. GRANOUX founder in Marseille. (Model variant on the original catalog: photo).

A representation of an Egyptian couple.

Around 1890.

Originally these flare doors were equipped with gas (hence the possibility of opening the rear with a trapdoor).

Electrified at the beginning of the 20th century, the current electrification has been revised and is fully operational.

Spectacular in their size: 190 cm and 186 cm max. (170 and 166 cm without their flame glassware).
