same year as the original edition. It is more extensive than the first, but does not include either the coat of arms plate or the plan of Reims which appeared in the first. It is decorated with nine beautiful filled plates which illustrate the different stages of the coronation and 39 plates which represent the costumes of the different dignitaries for the coronation.
