# Description

Fine Ghoum rug signed Master Mohammad Jamchidi, made in silk velvet on a foundation of silk, velvet, warps, weft and fringes. Characterized by a rare so-called "garden" decor with six rows of five boxes inlaid with stylized carpets, thrones, doors of ancient temples and palaces, as well as garden kiosks, compositions of stylized flower sprigs, garden landscapes, but also chalices, mirhabs, hanging oil lamps, and diamonds and colored stones in polychrome surrounded by stylized gutters supplying waterways into the boxes with symbols of life and creation in the garden. Four borders decorated with cartridge seedlings inlaid with motifs reminiscent of the central field and polychrome animal decoration Density approximately: 10/11000 knots per dm2
