Africanist stèle by Emile Eloi Robert

Large wooden stèle by Emile Eloi Robert (1880-1948).

Born into a modest family, Emile Eloi Robert trained at the Académie des Beaux-Arts de Rennes, before entering the Beaux-Arts de Paris in 1900, first in Alexandre Falguière's studio, then that of Antonin Mercié.

A great sculptor of the Breton soul, he was also passionate about African subjects, such as his famous *Tête de femme Mangbetu*.

The stèle we present is entirely in keeping with the passion for Africa felt by many artists at the time.
