

Spain, 18th century

Steel, bone, blond horn, brass and shagreen

Overall length: 46.5 cm Blade length: 28.1 cm

(restoration)

Single-edged straight steel blade with wide back, marked with a gutter and ending in a point.

Remains of engraved ornamental calligraphy.

Double inverted brass quillon guard, finished in volutes.

Turned bone fuse in the shape of a bulb and brown horn with fillet decoration. The pommel is in brass.
