Gouache on paper measuring 32cm x 45cm plus frame 52cm x 65cm representing an interior scene with three chairs and fruit bowl signed lower right Eugène BABOULENE is a great Provençal painter Born in Toulon in 1905 he was first a decorator then his meeting with Antoni Clavé was a determining factor for him, he found his style and enjoyed an international career. Painter and lithographer Qualified as "the most thoughtful of figurative" painters, this artist is considered one of the best painters of the contemporary Provençal School7. He is particularly fond of Provençal seascapes and landscapes, simple and warm atmospheres, which he paints with finesse in color harmonies in pastel tones.
