Circular in shape, resting on a slight heel. The presentation is more or less hollow, depending on the purpose of the plate. This one is slightly flat. The bottom, called the "basin", is surrounded by a more or less curved descent (or fall), bordered by a crown called the "wing" by manufacturers or "marli" in goldsmithing. HARD porcelain. White background with polychrome decoration of a PARROT connected to a shrub placed on a mound. The wing has a gray background, decorated with music and military attributes in sepia monochrome with gold highlights. Gold threads on the edges.
