HLéty Hippolyte Léty, born in Vienne an ancient town situated 35 km south of Lyon on the river Rhône, went to the Lyon School of Fine Arts where he studied under Tony Zac and Alexandre François Bonnardel, and then to the School of Fine Arts in Paris where he was taught by Léon Bonnat, Ferdinand Humbert et Luc-Olivier Merson. He began exhibiting at the Salons in Lyon and in Paris from the mid-1890s. For many years Léty was professor of painting at the Tourcoing School of Art near the Belgian border. But if working in the North, Léty's heart remained in the South-East, and he is one of the great
