Bronze "David", By A. Gaudez - Late 19th Century" Magnificent bronze print with brown patina, signed Adrien Etienne Gaudez (1845-1902), renowned French sculptor, gold medalist at the Paris Universal Exhibition in 1889. This work with a height of 41cm It depicts David, future king of Israel, who kills the hero of the Philistines, the giant Goliath, with a stone thrown with a slingshot. This biblical episode was chosen by the artist to salute. courage and strength, accentuated by the beauty of this bronze, David is represented naked, simply dressed in a sheepskin surrounding his hips. In his right hand, he firmly holds his sling. appearance is haughty and glorious, Period: Late 19th century Delivery, careful packaging and appropriate protection.
