Exceptional and rare mahogany chest of drawers, built in Empire period oak, stamped COURTE. It opens with four drawers, turquin gray blue marble top. Very high quality gilded and chiseled bronze ornamentations. Very rare piece of furniture. Empire period first quarter of the 19th century Jean Baptiste Courte or Kurt (September 20, 1749 - April 28, 1843), cabinetmaker, mastered on September 20, 1777 in Dijon. His furniture is often similar to that of Demoulin. These are Louis XVI chests of drawers and secretaries.
