This wool is the first wool of the lamb, it is taken under the belly and on the neck.

Around 1900-1930 we can hardly imagine the immense work to create such a marvel.

The quality of these Persian pieces is clear, the work is fine, precise and durable.

The materials used are of top quality, which means that these pieces remain in good used condition, 50 to 70 years later.

This rug is clean, the wool is soft, knotted beautifully and finely tight as these rugs always are. It reveals to us shades full of contrasts, many colors. Large bouquets placed on an orange field and an incredible medallion, orange, lichen green, blue and ivory.

It is surrounded by a border of bouquets of roses, lotus flowers, stylized flowers with nine bands. Traditional wool rug, comfortable and heavy duty. The nuances underline this learned floral design in the great tradition of Persian art which is also found in Mughal art, inspired by the miniatures of the school of Tabriz, then capital of the Persian empire, but completely revised in beginning of the 20th century.

Indeed, the Persian carpet trade has existed for several centuries and the trade, European and American demand, means that the workshops comply with the requirements of the sponsors and those since the sixteenth century.

For information: Tabriz (Azerbaijani: T?briz/?????, formerly Tauris), is the capital of the province of East Azerbaijan, in the northwest of Iran (Iranian Azerbaijan).

Tabriz is located on the course of the Talkheh River (also called Aji-Chai), near Lake Urmia, close to the borders of the Republic of Azerbaijan and Armenia. It is the gateway to Persia from north to west, Tabriz carpets have extreme importance in the quality of Persian carpets and a wonderful international reputation. Tabriz rugs are among the most popular rugs in the world, their work is always very fine and durable over time.
