REVOLVER DAGUE, patented Célestin DUMONTHIER, fully etched. France, 19th century Steel and ivory Length T. : 44cm - Length. of barrel with blade: 29cm - Cal. 12mm with pin

On the base of a revolver by Eugène LEFAUCHEUX model 1858, single-edged dagger topped by a 15-centimeter hexagonal barrel; the whole fully engraved with scrolling foliage, and marked on the left side DUMONTHIER B.S.C.D.G. and its number 200. Six-chamber barrel, engraved with bouquets of flowers and scrolls. Single action. Open-body bati, engraved en suite. Ivory stock plates, chased screws and rosettes.
