### Description

Little representation of the reclining Buddha in the last stage of his existence. Parinirvana is also called in the Pali canon anupadisesa nibbana, "nirvana without remainder of existence", or bhavanirodha, end of existence. It is the final victory over suffering (duhkha), in accordance with the four noble truths. Having completed what he wanted to teach in his sermons, he absorbed himself in the four degrees of meditation, culminating in the final and ineffable state of nirvana. Bronze or brass, made in two parts, in Nepal, during the 19th century.
