To be brief: on Asian pottery of Siberian origin we find these motifs joined with a reading linked to fertility rites... symbolization of phases of the moon by the alternation of white and black (light - darkness) (easy parallel: ying and yang as well as heaven and hell...° I leave it to you to discover this text from 1965: "Symbolism" checkerboard on pottery from the high Asian period and the solar myth of the Açvin-Dioscuri [article] Jacques Bernolles".
