Description

Lever earrings in 375/° yellow gold (9 KT, clover hallmarks) in two parts, with two sleepers supporting two removable pendants, adaptable format characteristic of Napoleon III period jewelry. Each part is decorated with a citrine, oval or pear. At the time, these stones were not heated... their color is therefore delicate in daylight, and particularly luminous in artificial light... These citrines are decorated with fine pearls just as characteristic of the 'era. This principle of pendants makes these buckles very mobile....in this context, it is probable that the gold content (9 KT) is a deliberate choice giving them great resistance over time... The sleeper systems are in accordance with the era designed to be passed through the back of the ear and easy to handle since they are articulated. The

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suspension ring of the lower part is hidden under a fine pearl of the sleeper which supports it, and therefore invisible to wear.
