Originally from Ardèche, this painter settled in Brignon in the Gard, with his wife Denise, also a painter. They created a Plastic Arts workshop there, which is still renowned today. Cavenago trained at the National School of Applied Arts, and throughout France, mainly landscapes that he seeks to simplify through his technique. As he said himself, knife painting with its small flat
