100 years this year!... It's the great anniversary of this very rare little 36-page book, illustrated by the famous English designer George Ernest Studdy (1878 - 1948).

" He began his career by selling a few drawings to publishers. Later, magazines and newspapers asked him to do illustrations for the Boer War (1899-1902). He published in Boys Own in 1900 and Comic Cut was the first publication to place regular orders in 1902, he published in Pick-Me-Up magazine and in The Big Budget Comic. He published a large number of postcards for Valentine's Postcards of Dundee. in The Sketch; this character became a weekly strip in Tit-Bits from 1926. This comic strip was published for a certain period and derivative products were produced and sold. He also painted
