Description

The scene depicted is inspired by mythology and classical Greco-Roman culture.

The iconographic elements, such as the togas, the musical instruments, and the column, are typical of representations of mythological scenes. Four full-length figures, draped in togas, participate in an offering or sacrifice ceremony around a central column. The characters and their attributes (flute, trays, thyrsus) suggest a religious ceremony, potentially a rite of sacrifice or an offering to the gods. The presence of the thyrsus could indicate a connection with the cult of Dionysus/Bacchus, the god of wine and festivities.
