Magnetic mystery clock

This is a mystery clock, very freely inspired by Robert Houdin's flying clock, it has a magnetic movement.

The magnet drives the steel globes of the regulator which itself drives the timer hidden behind the hands.

Subsidiary dials : thermometer and barometer

Late 19th century creation signed on the dial A Pygmalion in Constantinople.

French creation for the Ottoman market.

A singing bird clock with the same signature was sold to Drouot a few years ago.
