He later worked for other renowned designers and architects, including Le Corbusier and Charlotte Perriand. In the 1950s, Fernandez began working for the French automobile company Facel Vega, where he designed the interiors of the brand's luxury cars, including the famous Facel Vega HK500. He has also designed interiors for yachts, airplanes and hotels. In 1960, Fernandez established his own design agency, where he
