Description

Art Nouveau Pewter and Brass Perfume Set with Water Lilies, Signed E. Frères. A rare Art Nouveau decorative set in pewter and brass, circa 1900, decorated with water lilies, designed as a centerpiece or for diffusing perfumes, signed E. Frères. The set comprises a sculpted tray in the shape of a water lily leaf, supporting four small receptacles, including a central covered pot. It features a gently raised floral design, characteristic of the naturalist aesthetic of the late 19th/early 20th century, where the aquatic motif of the water lily plays a major symbolic role. The containers are made of a finely molded pewter structure, incorporating screw-on gilt brass cups designed to hold perfumed substances. The covered central pot, the focal point of the composition, reinforces the idea of the piece as a
