Description

This engraving, made by Nicolas de Larmessin (1638-1694), depicts Élisabeth Marie Louise, also known as Louise Marie Françoise de Savoie. She was Infanta of Portugal, daughter of Dom Pedro, Prince of Portugal, and married Victor Amédée, Duke of Savoy, on January 6, 1669. The engraving, dated 1680, shows the Infanta in ornate attire, typical of the nobility of the time. Nicolas de Larmessin, a renowned 17th-century French engraver, is known for his detailed portraits and precise illustrations. The work was produced in Paris, at the Widow Bertrand's Rue St Jacques, with the privilege of the King.
