He made a trip to Switzerland in 1783 with the painter Taunay, after his aggregation at the academy. largely, while putting his personal touch, major Dutch painters such as Jan Both and Nicholas Berchem for the sky and the characters with smiling faces, the animals of Paulus Potter, everything is tranquility and serenity and prefigures pre-romanticism.
