Aubusson tapestries and carpets are from the Renaissance arts and still play an important role in our culture today.

This Aubusson tapestry is a classic example of French Romanticism. It features a cartouche of flowers and foliage, a rooster associated with the Renaissance and therefore the return of summer, because it celebrates the return Dealer
