This very beautiful set comes from the workshops of Raingo et Frères. The four brothers, sons of the founder Zacharie, stood out for the excellence of their creations at the universal exhibitions of the mid-19th century.

These creations can be found in several museums around the world. The particularity of this clock incorporating the Renaissance and Antique architectural decorative vocabulary is the finesse of its bas-relief decoration enhanced by the brown patina, entirely in the spirit of Valadier. The clock is in the shape of an attic (Louvre) with a broken pediment.

The candelabra have a pilaster shaft (Blois), an Ionic capital, a base with sides decorated with

grotesques (Urfé), the four tiered arms of light support the girandole binet on a sphere.
