This 1931 watercolor depicts a historic scene in Strasbourg, more precisely the rue du Bain-aux-Plantes in the picturesque Petite France district. You can see half-timbered houses characteristic of Alsatian architecture, with their sloping roofs and their facades decorated with exposed wooden beams. The street is animated by a few characters, some of whom seem to be engaged in daily activities, such as the transportation of goods using a cart. Rue du Bain-aux-Plantes is one of the most famous and picturesque in the Petite France district of Strasbourg. It takes its name from an old medieval bathhouse, where locals came to wash themselves using plants for their medicinal properties. Lined with half-timbered houses dating from the 16th and 17th centuries, the street has colorful facades and wooden balconies, typical of Alsatian architecture. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Petite France is famous for its canals, covered bridges and cobbled streets, offering a unique medieval ambiance. A popular destination, the street hosts craft shops, traditional restaurants and cafes, attracting many visitors.
