Extremely rare watercolorist table in rosewood and sycamore, square section it opens with a top covered in burgundy leather gilded with small irons (wear) forming a desk revealing a pivoting locker, with a side drawer and a removable side shelf the turned bamboo uprights are joined by a spacer shelf and a base forming a plinth fitted with casters two small porcelain cups are present in the compartmentalized drawer Tiny wear over time and small cracks This piece of furniture can be attributed to the house Alphonse Giroux et Cie 7 rue du coq Saint Honoré in Paris of which several known similar examples are still mini with their label stuck or signed on the leather, ours is worn Dimensions height 75cm L32x32cm
