This clock is therefore dedicated to knowledge, knowledge, science and astronomy. The dial is silvered bronze. The wire betting movement works for a few minutes then stops. It will be advisable to have it calibrated by a watchmaker. The original mercury gilding is sublime, with mattes and shines. This is a very high quality and very decorative piece.
