Brand of SVE, Samuel van Eenhoorn, owner of the most famous Deflt factory, De Grieckse A, 1678-1686 Vase decorated in blue monochrome in the style of Chinese porcelain of the Kraak type from the Wanli period, compartments with Chinese furniture. Kraak porcelain was produced for the European market, Dutch merchants trading with carracks, porcelain of this style was named in reference to these trading ships. Chinese porcelain was very expensive and sought after in Europe in the 17th century. Some factories like Delft produced vases imitating these porcelains to meet market demands. Accident at the pass.
