Description

Persia - Caucasus, "SHAMCHIR", late 18th century. Buffalo horn handle mount with two rivets, the brass eyelets missing. Straight cruise with short diamond-shaped lugs and straight quillon ending in a half ball. Blade with strong curvature + 10 cm of arrow, with stained gray patina, flat back and dorsal gutter. This blade is engraved on both sides with a series of magic formula type numbers on two lines "1 2 3 4 5 6" and "8 9 7 4" and on one side the furnisher's punch to be identified in the shape of half moon Length: 93 cm Length of the blade: 81 cm Width at the heel of the blade: 3.5 cm Arrow of the blade: + 10 cm Shamchir in fairly good condition with traces of wear and absence eyelets, without sheath. A similar Shamchir with the same engraving on the blade is in the reserves of the
