The candelabras are in good overall condition.

Note that one candle holder is missing from each candelabra--each should have six--but this does not affect their beauty or functionality. This detail is reflected in the price. The slender stem and stable base, along with the beautiful patina, will add elegance and a touch of late 19th-century bohemian atmosphere to any table setting.

These candelabras combine the opulence of the Napoleonic style with the fluid elegance of Art Nouveau. The Oriental influence adds an extra layer of sophistication to the design.
