Jean Coraboeuf born in Pouillé-les Coteaux (Loire Atlantique) on November 6, 1870 and died in Paris on February 6, 1947 is a French painter and engraver. Jean-Auguste-Dominique Ingres is a French painter. After an initial apprenticeship in Montauban, his hometown, he became a student of Jacques-Louis David in Paris. Prix de Rome in 1801.
