Antique nude study, charcoal and white highlights on paper. Work from the first third of the 19th century. This scene depicting two antique warriors, in the style of the great works of David and his students, uses allegorical illustrations of ancient myths, praising the virtues of courage, fraternity, heroism, and sacrifice in a neoclassical style. An amusing feature of this studio study, created with period accessories, is that our warrior wears a Restoration-era firefighter's helmet, used to mimic that of a Greek soldier.Overall dimensions: height 69 cm - width 59 cm. Visible dimensions: height 59 cm - width 48 cm.In a giltwood frame, under glass. Visible wear on the edges, small marks, and vertical creases.
