Engraving of Southern Saxony, that is to say the duchy, the electorate, and the joint principality of the dukes of Saxony. This 18th century engraving more broadly represents South-East Germany and Bohemia (part of the Czech Republic). Printed by Zolmann and Zürner, a subsidiary of the Homann Heirs, in 1734. It includes Leipzig, Weimar, Dresden, Meissen, but also Jena, Berlin and Prague. Johann Baptist Homann (1664-1724) is a renowned German cartographer who founded his own publishing house. The company he founded was later called "Homann Erben" or Homann Heirs. Engraving and framing in very good condition. Original colors 62 x 78 cm. Careful packaging.
