The composition presents on a table, in the center a plucked chicken, flanked by a few birds hanging at the top right; on the right side, a bunch of carrots; on the left side a bunch of asparagus and a salad, the skin of the chicken and the bright colors create a chromatic contrast with the dark-toned background. Flemish School of the 17th century where we see the emergence of the realist classic which has its source in the United Provinces, a Protestant, bourgeois and merchant country. The Calvinist church suppresses painting in churches. Painters specialize in small-format paintings for a bourgeois clientele. Materialist conception of art (no religious ideal or classical Beauty) tending towards verism (it is not much of an imaginative painting), still life is now part of it.
