Beautiful light wood table in cherry and speckled Amboine veneer. It is characterized by two drawers with curved fronts and made of 5 Amboine plates. These two drawers are separated by a hollow cherry crosspiece, delimiting the rest of the piece of furniture. Two chiseled bronze bowl buttons adorn each drawer. The top of the piece of furniture in Amboine burl is surrounded by a cherry beak molding and small groove. This upper part rests on four turned legs in solid cherry placed on a moving wooden element, cut towards the top and bottom. A spacer connects these elements. Beautiful and functional, this living room table will seduce you with its bright Amboine speckled. ***** Period: 1st part of the 19th century Excellent condition after restoration in our workshop. Finish: Shellac
