Description

Set of 6 large wine glasses called Roemers in blown and cut double-colored crystal, enhanced with 24-carat fine gold.

Six different colors are present.

Emblem of the city of Nancy, the thistle inspired in 1908 a first service made for the International Exhibition of the East of France in Nancy at the height of the Art Nouveau movement. It was presented there accompanied by the motto of Nancy "Qui s'y frotte s'y pique" as a sign of Ludovician resistance under the German occupation.

In 1913, the name was anglicized to become Thistle (English translation of "Chardon") and has since shone on the greatest tables around the world.
