A Renaissance gold ring set with a turquoise.

Western Europe, first half of the 16th century.

Ring size J 1/2 UK / 5 US.

The bezel measures 1 x 0.9cm.

Weighs 3.4 grams.

The fine gold ring is set with a high pie-crust bezel with a cabochon turquoise within a rub over setting.
