HENOCQUE Narcisse, Born in 1879, died in 1952. 19th- 20th centuries. French. Painter of portraits, landscapes, seascapes, flowers and fruits. Neo-impressionist. He was a student of Zacharie at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Rouen. Then, with school friends, he formed, around Joseph Delattre, the Rouen Neo-Impressionist School, among which Dumont and Narcisse Guilbert are often cited. Following Delattre's example, he lingered on the banks of the Seine, the surrounding meadows or the seaside. An
