A collection of three Chinese porcelain blue and white Kangxi 'Longevity' vases.  
China, Kangxi period (1661-1722).

Each vase of hexagonal form, painted to the exterior on each of the six sides with flowering chrysanthemum branches growing from rocks, surrounded by insects, decorated with ruyi heads or lingzhi fungus below. The neck is also painted with a floral decor, flanked by two gilt handles in the form of mythical creatures.

### Symbolism:

The chrysanthemum (juhua ??), rock (shoeshi ??) and fungus (lingzhi ??) are all symbols of longevity.
