Pair of caned benches in natural wood resting on six arched legs. The scalloped belt is carved with staples and acanthus leaf motifs on the foot falls. The seat is straight on all sides except on the front where a play of curves and counter-curves brings movement to the structure. Attributed to Jean-Baptiste Gourdin Louis XV period Usual restorations, restorations to one leg, formerly lacquered H. 37.5 x W. 129 x D. 44.5 cm
